However, the United States Supreme Court, relying upon the Federal Arbitration Act, has imposed arbitration on the parties in a wide variety of circumstances. Now, Pennsylvania joins the rush to Alternative Dispute Resolution as a result of its new law. Rieders is regarded as one of the best known teachers and litigators in the Commonwealth, a former President of the Pennsylvania Association for Justice. Cliff Rieders is a published author of many textbooks, op-eds, and writes on a variety of topics.
